

Hon Hai Technology Group (Foxconn) Biodiversity and No Deforestation Commitment

Hon Hai Technology Group (Foxconn) believes that biodiversity and forest conservation are important issues for the sustainability of the Earth. We therefore issue Biodiversity and No Deforestation Commitment to publicly commit to our goals for sustainable operations. This commitment covers the Group, suppliers, and partners, aiming at sustainable development to demonstrate the company's core values in ecological conservation. At Hon Hai Technology Group (Foxconn), we implement the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in our own operations, including SDG 14: Life below water, SDG 15: Life on land, and SDG 17: Partnerships for the goals. We moreover coordinate collaborative joint efforts with value chain partners for biodiversity conservation and no deforestation.

Principles and Commitments:

1. We uphold our core values for sustainable operations and human–wildlife coexistence. We strive to maintain global biodiversity by developing clean manufacturing.
2. We adhere to the principles of “green, ecological, natural, zero emissions, recyclability, continuously following the relevant governments’ forest and biodiversity regulations and guidelines. We avoid building facilities and having operational activities in globally or nationally important sites for biodiversity.
3. We achieve net positive impact on biodiversity and zero net deforestation by 2050, committed to preserving biodiversity and preventing deforestation.
4. If it is necessary to conduct operations and/or other operational activities at/or near sites containing globally or nationally important biodiversity, we take mitigation hierarchy measures to avoid, minimize, restore, and/or offset, reducing our ecological footprint. Suppliers across our supply chain are required to hold up to the same standards.
5. We leverage the Group’s resources and influence to increase awareness on biodiversity and no deforestation among employees, shareholders, partners, suppliers, and external stakeholders to foster joint action.
6. We actively participate in actions to preserve biodiversity and respond to initiatives including the UN’s Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD).

Our Actions:

“Green, ecological, natural, zero emissions, and recyclability” has long been at the core of the Group’s policy for environment management. We identify and minimize the impact that products and facilities have on the surrounding ecological environment, thus reducing adverse effects on the environment, the communities, and natural resources.

1. We share with employees and suppliers knowledge of biodiversity and call-to-action guidelines. On the other hand, we require our employees and supply chain partners to comply with biodiversity-related regulations.
2. We promote biodiversity environmental education to raise ecological conservation awareness among employees, their families, and the general public, fulfilling the responsibilities of global citizens.
3. Through biodiversity risk assessment, we identify the dependency and impact of our activities on natural resources, and take actions to enhance the implementation of our strategic plan for restoring biodiversity, using circular economy model to restore marine life and their habitats.
4. We implement green solutions and circular economy practices to improve resource efficiency, thus minimizing the impact on the environment.
5. We take regional sustainability as one of the priorities for site selection.
6. We support biodiversity surveys and the development of monitoring technologies.
